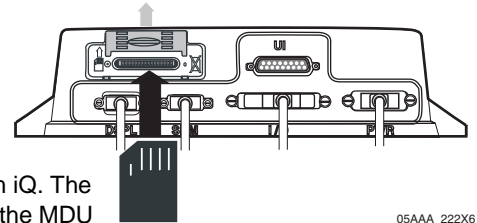

For a successful installation, follow these steps:

1. Install the user interface (CDU or MDU) according to the *Qualcomm Mobile Computing Platform and Accessory Installation Guide*, 80-J4866-1.
2. Insert the Maptuit NaviGo secure digital (SD) card into the SD card slot on the mobile application server (MAS). The card must remain inserted in the MAS for the Maptuit NaviGo application to operate.
3. Enable the Maptuit NaviGo service and Driver Login for the Qualcomm unit from iQ. The Maptuit NaviGo service is enabled if the Navigation icon on the Home screen of the MDU is **not** grayed out.
4. To start the Maptuit NaviGo service, first login using the Driver Login icon and then touch the Navigation icon. The six buttons within the Navigation screens show in color after the driver has successfully logged in.

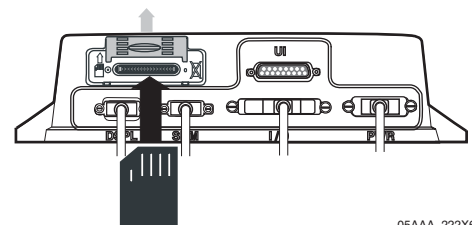
